- **Biomedical** — HIV/AIDS services, Continuous Medical Education (CME), and the 90-90-90 HIV cascade.
- **Behavioural** — Community-Led Monitoring (CLM) training, rights education and mental health support.
- **Structural** — Law-enforcement sensitization, policy advocacy and our Service Charter.
