Programmes Fact Sheet

Programme	What it does
CLM Training	Community-Led Monitoring training that equips sex workers to oversee and monitor the medical services delivered to them.
Mental Health Retreat	Retreats for staff and beneficiaries focused on psychosocial wellbeing and peer support.
Continuous Medical Education (CME)	Sessions at partner facilities (Juja & Githiga Hospitals) to improve service delivery; Githiga supported by Red Cross and BHESP.
Police & Law-Enforcement Sensitization	Workshops with police and county law enforcement on the human rights of sex workers, led by Founder Melba Katindi.
County Health Management Sensitization	Consultative meetings with the county health team on key-population services and the 90-90-90 HIV cascade.
Service Charter	A launched Charter that guides visitors and the secretariat on service-delivery standards.
Community Feeding Programme	Food relief provided to sex workers in Kiambu County during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Focus Areas

- **Biomedical:** HIV/AIDS services, CME, 90-90-90 cascade.
- **Behavioural:** CLM training, rights education, mental health.
- **Structural:** Law-enforcement sensitization, policy advocacy, service charter.
